- Supportive Hearing this was discussed at our fall meeting as it was the annual summer maintenance of the classroom devices.
- Turkey Lunch \$379.00 was the amount of pizza for all students in January as our annual Christmas lunch was postponed. The original milk was free from the Dairy Farmers of Ontario and handed out prior to Christmas break. The milk expense on the postponed date was put through the snack program (OSNP)
- Hot Lunches: this is the biggest area of change. You can see the gross revenue at \$4,679.50. Expenses up until the end of January are: \$2,022.69. The chicken package is new and we haven't had A&W burgers in 2 years so I can't judge just yet how much those items will affect our profits.
